OUR FATHER IN FAITH

The Letter to the Hebrews today sings a hymn of praise to Abraham and to his faith, upon which are founded the religions of Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. Abraham is called "father" in faith by more people on earth than anybody else, numerous as the sands of the seashore or the stars of the heavens. Hebrews tells us it was this foundational faith that led Abraham to obey God's call when he heard it, though he was called to journey to a land he did not know and told he would father a mighty race through a marriage he thought was barren. But Abraham's faith, the author of Hebrews tells us, was his realization of what he hoped for, and the evidence of what he could not see. How often are we, in simple daily events of our own Christian vocation, called to an unfamiliar place or told we are to do something we do not believe we can? How fortunate we are to have Father Abraham as our guide and example!

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

The RCIA program at St. Peter, Prince of the Apostles Parish will start the second week of August 2016. The classes are on Sunday Mornings starting at 10 am until 12 noon. There is no charge for the program.

The RCIA process is designed for unbaptized individuals (called catechumens) seeking the fullness of the Christian life and to become disciples of Jesus, their teacher. This includes an initiation into the mystery of salvation, the practice of faith, hope and love, and other virtues in a succession of liturgical rites.

For persons baptized into another Christian Church and now seeking full communion with the Catholic Church are also welcomed to participate along with catechumens in the RCIA in the process of learning about the Catholic faith and being formed in that faith. They bring to the process of preparation their prior experience of Christian life and prayer.

Full communion with the Catholic Church involves reception of the Sacraments of Baptism; Penance and Reconciliation; a Profession of Faith followed by the celebration of Confirmation, Eucharist and Matrimony. Reception of the sacraments of initiation occurs at the Easter Vigil Mass. For more information, please call Joe A. Alaniz at 361-241-2411 or the parish office.
